WORK SESSION MINUTES

The work session was called to order by Mayor Edwards at 5:00pm. Mayor Edwards requested Interim City Manager Ruth Jones to introduce the City staff.

Mayor Edwards then requested the Interim City Attorney Josh Belinfante to discuss the Resolutions on the printed agenda and the status of negotiations.

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Councilmembers and the Mayor then asked Attorney Belinfante questions about their specific areas of interest.

As a result of the discussion, a motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Rowell and seconded by Councilmember Willis to authorize the City Manager Jones and City Attorney Belinfante to negotiate with all parties listed on the agenda as Resolutions or Ordinances, to authorize these negotiations by moving this approval by Council to the Consent Agenda, and to bring back the Resolutions authorizing such agreements at the next regular meeting (May 23, 2017). The motion carried unanimously.

Next the Interim City Attorney led a discussion with regard to the Zoning Procedures Act and the impact of the moratorium enacted by the City Council at their first meeting on April 29, 2017.

Councilmembers and the Mayor then asked Attorney Belinfante questions about their specific areas of interest.

At the conclusion of the discussion, the Clerk made an announcement to the public in attendance regarding the opportunity to make public comment during the Regular Meeting agenda.

A motion was made by Councilmember Willis and seconded by Councilmember Jackson to adjourn the Work Session. The motion carried unanimously. The Work Session was adjourned at 5:39pm.
