a. A motion was made by Councilmember Gumbs and seconded by Councilmember Jackson to change the title of Assistant to the City Manager to Assistant City Manager and to also change the qualifications to be reflective of Assistant City Manager. The motion passed unanimously, 7-0-0.

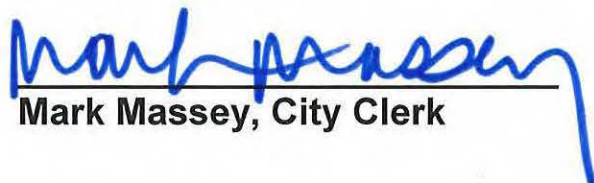
f. A motion was made by Councilmember Willis at 11:12am to adjourn the meeting. The motion failed, due to a lack of no second.

8 A RESOLUTION TO AMEND CITY ADMINISTRATIVE CLASSIFICATIONS, TO
9 ENHANCE ADMINISTRATIVE EFFICIENCY AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES

10 WHEREAS, the City of South Fulton ("City") is a municipal corporation duly
11 organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;
12

13 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council ("City Council") is the duly elected governing
14 authority of the City;

15 WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered through the City Charter to establish,
16 abolish, merge, or consolidate offices, positions of employment, departments, and
17 agencies of the city as it shall deem necessary for the proper administration of the
18 affairs of the government of the city. Charter 3.10(c); and

19 WHEREAS, this resolution will benefit the health and general welfare of the City,
20 its citizens and general public.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF SOUTH FULTON, GEORGIA
22 HEREBY RESOLVES:

23 Section 1. The position of "Assistant to the City Manager" is hereby reclassified to
24 "Assistant City Manager," and shall be assigned the appropriate qualifications and
25 paygrade for an assistant city manager position by the City Human Resource
26 Department, in accordance with Human Resource protocols.

27 Section 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that: (a)
28 All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Resolution are or
29 were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable
30 and constitutional.

31 (b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph,
32 sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is severable from every other section,
33 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution. No section, paragraph,
34 sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is mutually dependent upon any other
35 section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

36 (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this
37 Resolution shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or
38 otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent
39 jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity,

40 unconstitutional or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not
41 render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining
42 phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Resolution.

43 **Section 3.** All Resolutions and parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby
44 expressly repealed.

45 **Section 4.** The effective date of this Resolution shall be the date of adoption unless
46 provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.
