4. Presentations

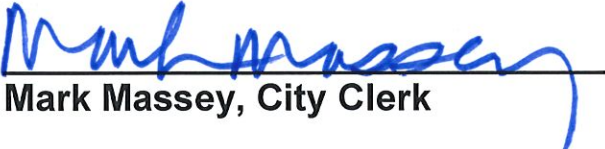
